Free Places to Stay - Websites

Want to travel Europe cheap? Try these free-places-to-stay websites. Unlike the “Work Exchange” websites, these sites offer free places to stay that, typically, do not involve any work.

Depending on who you ask, the hosts may expect their guests to “demonstrate value” in some way, by preparing a meal inspired by their home country, telling a story about their travels, or even inviting the hosts to come stay at their place in their home country.

Stay with locals and meet travelers

Essentially, couch surfing is a homestay exchange that allows people (hosts) to host travelers, offering them a “couch” or a bed or even a room to use. Reviews can be left for the “host” which builds up his credibility score. Also, hosts can leave reviews for the travelers, to help with their credibility and trustworthiness.

How to Travel Europe for cheap: A basic overview

If you want to travel Europe for cheap, you can do this:

1. Join some of the “Work Exchange” websites and join some of the “Free Places to Stay - Websites”. Bookmark them on your laptop, computer, tablet, smartphone. If they have apps, download the apps.
2. Plan where you want to go—the countries, the route, the length of time you intend to be in each country, etc.
3. Schedule your itinerary to include “work exchange” and “free places” so that you have accommodations.
4. Join Facebook groups, Facebook pages, follow Instagram channels, subscribe to YouTube channels, that offer information about the places you intend to travel. If possible, connect with people on social media who live in or are visiting the countries you intend to visit. Perhaps you could arrange to stay at their place in exchange for some light chores.
5. Get your passport and if possible, get a passport card, too.
6. Research what you need to do to get phone service when overseas. This might mean buying an “unlocked” cell phone so you can use it internationally. It might mean buying a SIM card at your destination.

7. Select clothing that is appropriate for the weather that is expected during the seasons and locations for where you intend to travel.
8. Before you go, research the passport and visa requirements of the countries you intend to travel to. If possible, arrange to have someone meet you at the airport or, if you're traveling by train or bus or car, your arrival destination.
8. Take pictures of your passport and any identification cards, as well as credit cards, etc, and post them to a flash drive that has a password and also upload them to mega.nz You can set up the file so that it is password-protected.
9. Set up a proton.me email account. It is supposed to be very secure. Use this to store passwords for your mega.nz account and also banking information and other data that requires secure access
10. If you intend to travel for an extended period, try to sell or donate most of your possessions. The possessions that you do intend to keep, try to arrange to store them at a friend's place, perhaps an unused closet or storage area, for a monthly fee. This way, if you decide to stay in another country, you could arrange for your friend to sell or keep or donate the items they are storing for you.
